CALL FOR PROPOSALS IN MORE DETAIL It is our great pleasure to invite proposal submissions for the first CitEdEV International Students Conference *Citizenship Education in Divided Times: Building connections through values* that will be held at Charles University, Prague, Czech Republic, Wednesday 25th to Thursday 26th of May 2022.

The conference is organised by the Jean Monnet Network [Citizenship Education in the Context Of European Values: Educational Aspects \(CitEdEV\)](#), an EU co-funded platform for knowledge sharing and cooperation of experts in the field of citizenship and values education and [Children's Identity & Citizenship European Association \(CiCea\)](#), one of the leading organizations promoting the teaching and research of Citizenship Education in Europe and the rest of the world.

Proposals are invited on citizenship and citizenship education and on the effect of pandemic on citizenship related issues. Other related topics are for example values and value changes, social identity, social justice, migration, acculturation, ethnic relationships, diversity, intercultural issues, social exclusion-inclusion, historical culture, sustainability, environmental issues, economic growth and economic crisis and their implications on citizenship and identity, employment, distribution of wealth and social justice and etc. Papers are welcome from different disciplines including education, sociology, political science, history, psychology and philosophy.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE CONFERENCE FOR PARTICIPANTS

The student conference welcomes **participants**, who present a paper, and **audience members**, who do not present a paper but form part of the audience.

The number of participants who will be selected to present their papers is limited to **twelve**. The number of audience participants will not be limited.

We encourage you to send your proposal as early as possible to be considered by Scientific Committee of the student conference.

The conference will start on 25th May with morning and afternoon sessions. On the second day, 26th May (Thursday) there will be only a morning session and the farewell lunch.

CERTIFICATION OF ATTENDANCE

Presenting participants are expected to be present in all sessions of the student conference, from the very beginning to the very end to get a Certificate of Attendance. Please do not conceptualize your presence as at other conferences, namely coming to present your paper and then leaving. This is a joint, group endeavour with different activities that require your active presence during the one and a half day. Please apply only if you can be present during the whole process.

CONFERENCE FEES

The fee for the Student Conference is **€ 60**. The conference fees cover meals and refreshments in the conference sessions. There is no dinner included. You will also be responsible for your travel and accommodation. We are working on offering affordable accommodation.

After the International Student Conference, participating students can attend the **CitEdEV Conference**, which immediately follows. Attendance to the main conference must be booked and paid for separately for those who are not members of the CitEdEV Network.

No fees are charged for CitEdEV Network members.

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION LINK

Proposals must be submitted via form at [this link](#) (at the very bottom). We cannot accept submissions by any other means. Please do not send them in any other way.

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

You must submit an abstract of no more than 500 words. The abstract is used by the Conference Scientific Committee to decide if your paper appears to be of sufficient quality to be selected.

The abstract should describe your proposal, telling your audience what it is about. Please write in full sentences not bullet points.

Attention: If you are at the beginning of your doctoral studies and you still do not have results, you provide a theoretical background, the research question and the planned (!) methodology and you can leave out the result section or describe the expected results.

ABSTRACT REQUIREMENTS

Title of the paper, the author and the affiliation

Summary of the project: what you have set out to do, how you have done it, the key findings and results. This consists of the following:

- **Introduction:** clear statement of the problem that you are addressing, and a short theoretical background. These should then lead to declarations of project aims and objectives
- **Methodology:** participants of the study (if applicable), the basis of the technique that you are using or the procedure that you have adopted in your study
- **Results** section (if appropriate) - you should show illustrative examples of the main results of the work
- **Conclusion** section, listing the main findings of your investigation
- **Further Work Plan:** recommendations and thoughts about how the work could be progressed; other tests that could be applied, etc.
